Material List:

Surface: Gourd, Wood or Paper Mache

Variety of colored Pencils.. I used PrismaColorPremier by Berol

Tracing paper

12 inch square of Black poster paper or a piece of Poster paper painted black or color of choice (practice surface)

White Gesso

Black acrylic or color of choice for background

White Charcoal Pencil

Fine Point Stylus or Old Ball Point Pen

Fine or Ultra fine Black Sharpie

Flat Brushes.. 1/4 and 3/8 inch or 1/2 inch

Small stiff brush (old scuffy one is good)

Hand held pencil sharpener

Q-tips

Scotch tape

Painters tape

Package clear tape (optional)

Hair dryer or hand fan will come in handy

1. Paint surface at least two coats of acrylic paint.... letting it dry completely between coats. Surface should be nice and smooth.
2. Make sure surface is good and dry before starting project.
